We are an active and growing family church and we meet each week across five communities for worship and encouragement (see the table opposite). Each one is different, so there is one that will help you connect and grow.

SUNDAYS

09:00	Sanctuary	A quieter way to start the day, with a traditional communion and some sung worship. Refreshments afterwards and a chance to meet and chat.
11:00	Engage	Suitable for all ages with band led worship and groups for children. Sunday groups run in the Centre (see over for more information) and there is an All Age service on most 1st Sundays. Refreshments before and after the service.
16:00	Salt	A short informal service with food, drink and socialising time. Refreshing, different, accessible. <i>Currently 2nd Sunday only, but this may change. See Website.</i>
18:00	Encounter	Extended worship, teaching and the opportunity to respond. Youth led once a month.

10:00	Holy Communion	A traditional service, usually with an organist and hymns, a short talk and Holy Communion. Refreshments afterwards.
