

Colour the template pages

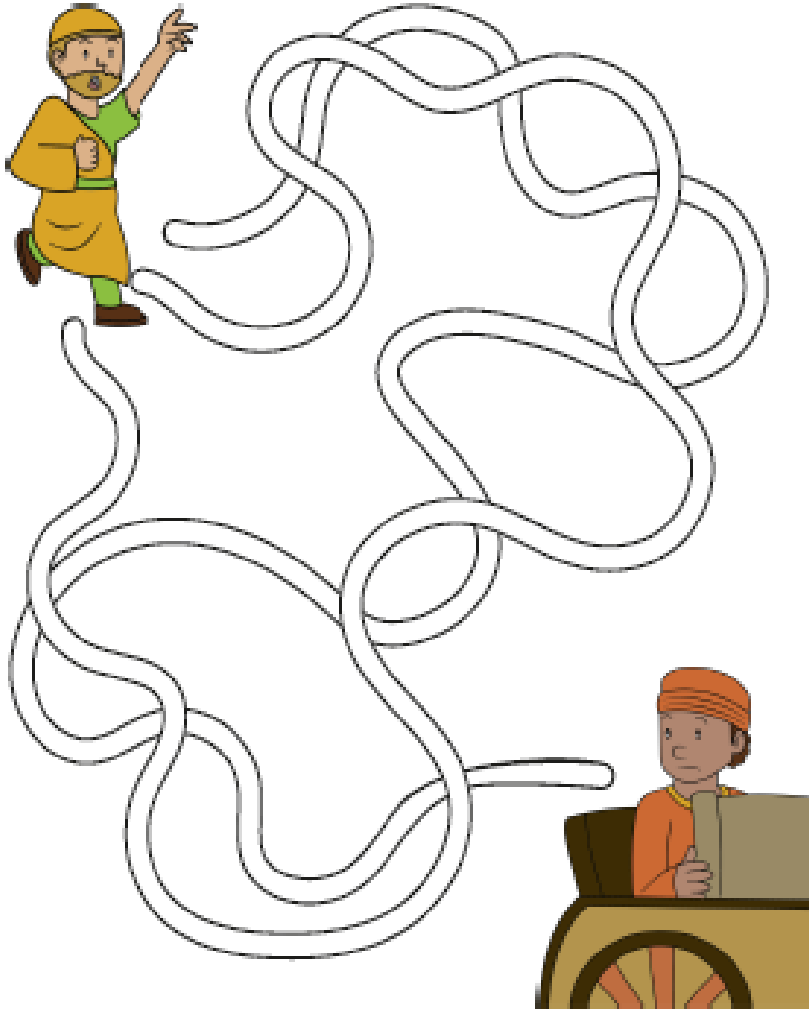


Cut out parts. Glue chariot together.
